



ALZConnected Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is ALZConnected®?

ALZConnected® is a free online community for everyone affected by Alzheimer's or another dementia; including people with Alzheimer's and their caregivers, friends, family members and neighbors, and also those who have lost someone to the disease. Members can share questions, experiences and practical tips via virtual message boards and live chat rooms, or create private groups on specific topics.

ALZConnected members can:

- Connect and communicate online with people who understand their challenges.
- Pose questions and offer solutions on dementia-related issues.
- Chat live with other members in chat rooms.

Q: Is there a fee to join ALZConnected?

ALZConnected is a free service; there is no fee to join or participate.

Q: Can I access any features without signing in?

You can tour the community and review the public content areas without being required to register. However, if you'd like to post a comment or offer a solution, you must have an account.

Q: Is ALZConnected for people living with Alzheimer's or their caregivers?

Anyone affected by Alzheimer's is welcome to join ALZConnected. There are message board forums for persons with Alzheimer's and for caregivers, which may include spouses, adult children, grandchildren, neighbors and friends. There are also message boards for people who provide professional care and for people who have lost someone to Alzheimer's disease. Members can also create private groups, which are an ideal way for families and care teams to communicate.

Q: Why should I join ALZConnected?

ALZConnected combines features of many popular social networking sites along with standard message board functionality and real-time conversation in chat rooms. ALZConnected is unique in that it is a community of support specifically for people facing Alzheimer's disease and other dementias.




Q: What if I want to join ALZConnected, but I'm not tech savvy?
